




AO User Registration Instructions


- 1. Navigate to https://qsep.cms.gov.
- 2. Accrediting Organization (AO) Sign-Up
 - a. Select "Sign Up."
 - b. Select "Providers & Other Learners."
 - c. Identify yourself: Enter first name, last name, and email address (twice). (Note: Your email address must be from your Accrediting Organization.) Select the "Accrediting Organization" role from the drop-down list of user roles.
 - d. When the form is complete, select the "Next" button at the bottom of the window.



- e. Select an **AO Type** from the drop-down menu at the left side of the form (see above in red).
- f. Select an AO Name from the drop-down menu on the right side of the form (see above in green).
- g. Select an AO Profession from the drop-down menu on the left side of the form (see above in purple).
- h. Once the AO information is complete, select "Next." A confirmation email will be sent to you with a link to the Quality, Safety & Education Portal (QSEP) Training Catalog. If you do not receive a confirmation email, please contact the QSEP Help Desk at 1-855-791-8900.
- 3. Accrediting Organization Login
 - a. Select "Login" button on the QSEP home page.
 - b. Select "Providers & Other Learners."
 - c. Enter your email address.
 - d. Select "Next."


4. Locate a Training

a. Upon login, you will be directed to the QSEP Training Catalog, which is organized alphabetically.



5. Launch Training and Get a Certificate of Completion

a. Select "Launch" (or "Resume") action button.



- b. Once the training is launched, the Training Menu window will appear with pretest, training, and posttest links. Select one of the links to start the learning experience.
- c. Once the training is completed, a certificate icon will appear next to the action button. Select the icon to view and print the certificate of completion.
